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SRATI Clinical Trial Network: Call for Study Centers

Benefits

A CTN support is provided for Study Management. The support is intended mainly to cover travel costs for steering committee meetings, use of a statistician, and possibly study coordination assistance at the institution of the principal investigator (PI). In addition to the financial support, the SRATI offers to the PI and steering committee members a valuable coordination support package:

- administrative,
- technical and logistic help for all phases of the study: preparation of documents,
- centre set-up and coordination,
- case report forms and cleaning of the data.

Eligibility

Every physician can apply for support by the SRATI - CTN. Non - SRATI members who are health care professionals are entitled to present proposals in the field of clinical anaesthesiology research on an international level.

- The SRATI - CTN is open to all clinicians meeting study protocol criteria.
- Centres throughout Europe are invited to participate in SRATI - CTN studies.
- In case several individuals from the same department apply to participate in the same study, only one person for each centre will be appointed as responsible for the centre and will be referred to as 'Local Coordinator'.

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- If several departments from the same institution apply to participate in a SRATI - CTN study and if these departments have buildings at different locations, it may be possible to consider the 2 locations as 2 separate study sites.
- For all SRATI Sponsored studies, at least one person of the Institution taking part in the CTN study must be an SRATI member and will be required to provide an SRATI membership identification.

Process

You are invited to submit contact details on behalf of your hospital in order to become an SRATI - CTN centre participating in one or more studies.

- Completion of the Call for Centres Form will facilitate coordination and is mandatory for registering the Institution's participation in an SRATI - CTN study.
- All fields on the 'Call for Centres form' marked with an asterisk are mandatory.
- The SRATI Secretariat will acknowledge receipt of the 'Call for Centres form' and will contact centres providing them with additional study information.
